Since 1980, Tarrant County area school districts have come to rely on The Parenting Center to provide PEPS, an interactive, threeday child abuse prevention program, to students who are enrolled in the required Health I course. In PEPS, youth learn ways to recognize and prevent child abuse, create healthy relationships, and utilize positive parenting skills.

PEPS currently reaches close to 6,500 students each year. The knowledge youth gain through PEPS may be the only education they receive in their entire lifetime that provides them with the tools to break a generational cycle of abuse. The **nurturing parenting philosophy** states that parenting is learned - the way parents were raised directly influences the way they raise their children. The Nurturing Parenting program helps parents learn nurturing behaviors in place of others that may be hurtful to children.

The Nurturing Parenting Series is designed to build nurturing parenting skills. Parents and children attend separate groups that meet concurrently with cognitive and affective activities. These activities are designed to build self-awareness, positive self-esteem and empathy, teach alternatives to yelling and hitting, enhance family communication and awareness of needs, replace abusive behavior with nurturing, promote healthy physical and emotional development and teach appropriate role and developmental expectations.
