Summary | Parent Educators at The Parenting Center encourage, motivate and provide information to parents and caregivers in order to enhance positive parenting skills. This role is designed to help parents identify and reduce behavior which might lead to child abuse as well as encourage positive parenting skills. As a Contract Parent Educator, all curricula will be provided to you and you will have the option to participate in program meetings and other trainings and professional developments. Contract Parent Educators also have the option to gain additional hours through curriculum revision and development.

Responsibilities and Duties |

- Prepare for classes by reviewing materials and curriculum.
- Teach assigned classes either virtually or in-person to parents and/or caregivers.
- Administer pretests/posttests and surveys for each class taught.
- Keep a high level of engagement with participants.
- Create and maintain relationships with Tarrant county high schools and other youth-serving organizations.

Must have public speaking and group facilitation abilities.
