Day to Day Functions | Follow all agency policies and procedures and all professional codes of ethics.

- Prepare for classes by reviewing materials and curriculum
- Present family life education to groups (virtually or in-person) with excellent facilitation skills to keep high level of engagement of parents and/or caregivers, with fidelity to curriculum
- Administer pretests/posttests and surveys for each class taught
- Keep a high level of engagement with participants
- Create and maintain relationships with Tarrant county high schools and other youth-serving organizations

Requirements | Bachelor's Degree in child development or social services field, Master's Degree preferred (required to teach Co-Parenting Essentials and Kids First).

- Must be fluent in English and Spanish to facilitate classes.
- Must be able to pass a background check.
- Must have a valid Texas driver's license, own reliable transportation with auto liability insurance, ability to work evenings and weekends according to class schedule.

- Teaching experience preferred.
- Knowledge of child development and child abuse prevention strategies.
- Must have public speaking and group facilitation abilities.
