Summary | Support the mission of The Parenting Center through Parent Coaching. The Bilingual Parent Educator will provide weekly home visiting services and lead parent education group classes, utilizing the TBRI® (Trust-Based Relational Intervention) and Parent Café curricula, to teach parents about creating healthy attachments, address physical needs and learn how to correct behavior that creates healthy parent-child interactions.

Day-to-Day Functions | Provide individualized education for caregivers of children ages 3-16 years of age. The position also requires the administration of the ASQ, other surveys and data management, along with satisfaction surveys, participate in program meetings and other trainings. Follow all policies for the agency and for the program, including grant guidelines. Educators will serve participants throughout Tarrant County.

Hours: Full-time (40 hours per week) with ability to work 2 to 3 evenings a week and occasional weekend time. Schedule will need to be flexible to meet the needs of the clients.
