#### PARENT COACHING

One goal. Two options. Designed to meet the individual needs of families with children between the ages of 3 and 16, our parent coaching programs provide you with the tools to talk with your kids, understand why they do what they do and ultimately strengthen your family's connections and create stronger bonds. Services are offered in-home and virtually in English and Spanish.

The **Nest Program** helps build up the trust and attachment between parents and their kids. Through the program, parents become more self aware and attuned to their children and behaviors. And, it all leads to a stronger relationship that helps empower kids and creates confidence. Parent coaches spend 10 weeks in each family's home or virtual visits, ensuring parents connect, correct and empower their children."

Our **Nurturing Program** allows each family to choose aspects of their plan to work toward a more unified family, from limiting screen time to building and creating schedules, and even parenting a child with ADHD. Call 817-632-5521 for information.
